S.No.	Query of Bidder	Clarification/ Reply
1.	Expected number of candidates for Border Recruitment.	Approximately 40,000 candidates are expected to apply for Border Battalions.
2.	Expected number of candidates for Women Battalions	Approximately 20,000 candidates are expected to apply for Women Battalions.
3.	Whether it will be a joint advertisement and concurrent examination or both are to be conducted separately.	Two different advertisement notifications for two Women and two Border Battalions have been issued. However, so far as the process of PET/PST is concerned, the Police Recruitment Board will try to conduct the recruitment of Border & Women Battalions concurrently at 05 locations viz. Jammu, Rajouri, Baramulla, Leh and Kargil. For remaining 04 locations viz. Udhampur, Doda, Anantnag and Srinagar Board will conduct the recruitment process for Women Battalions separately.
4.	Expected time to start the procedure from the date of tender allotment.	The recruitment will start at the earliest and it is expected to take less than two months to start the process from the date of tender allotment.
5.	Device required for shot-put measurement.	It is desirable that the shot-put measurement may be done electronically; however, if the electronic device is not available the measurement can be done manually also.
6.	Requirement of Digital height measurement for PST.	Yes, the Board requires Digital height measurement system for PST. However, manual stand shall also be made available for satisfaction of candidates.
7.	Type or extent of videography at the examination centre.	Every examination centre / Hall shall be covered with high resolution CCTV Cameras. The examination process will also be video graphed for which adequate number of videographers shall be made available.
8.	Collection of UID information of candidates during application process.	Yes, the candidates shall be advised to upload their specimen signature/ thumb impression of both their hands as well as recent passport size photograph at the time of filling/ uploading their application form. The candidate shall also mention their Aadhar number in application form. <i>(the above is the minimum requirement for establishing the identity of a candidate)</i>
9.	Maximum number of candidates for PET per day.	The number of candidates to be examined on each day for PET/ PST will depend on the availability of time and weather. However, it is expected that the number of candidates to be examined for PET/ PST will not be less than two thousand per day.

10.	Need of carbonless OMR sheets.	We require 1+2 carbonless OMR sheets for conducting written test of the candidates.
11.	Rates quoted are inclusive or exclusive of GST.	The GST shall be as per existing norm at the time of the payment and shall be exclusive of the rates quoted.

(B) Besides above, Clause 6 is added to Annexure –II (Commercial) of the e-NIT to the extent that the intending firm should have an experience of recruiting at least 50000 candidates in one exam including PET of at least 2000 candidates.


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
