



OFFICE OF CHAIRMAN POLICE RECRUITMENT BOARD
FOR 02-BORDER BATTALIONS PHQ J&K SRINAGAR

ORDER

Whereas, Police Headquarters (PHQ) J&K vide advertisement notice No. Pers-Rectt-A-105/2018/16207-50 dated 09.03.2019 invited online application forms for the post of constable in 02 Border Battalions of J&K Police from the eligible candidates residing within the radius of 0-10 Kms from International Border/Line of Control/ Actual Ground position line/Line of Actual Control (IB/LOC/AGPL/LAC) for carrying out the recruitment process under Transparent Recruitment Process (TRP).

Whereas, Physical Endurance Test/Physical Standard Test (PET/PST) in respect of aspiring candidates was conducted at identified locations by the implementing firm under the supervision of Police Recruitment Board (PRB).

Whereas, PHQ J&K vide notice No. Pers-Rectt-A-105-2018/2500-50 dated 11.01.2022 issued a fresh advertisement notification in continuation to the earlier one in pursuance to government of J&K, Home Department letter No. Home-PNG/201/2021-01-(CC-45001) dated 17.12.2021 inviting fresh application forms so as to give opportunity to eligible candidates who are domicile of J&K to apply and participate in the selection process as per the existing rules.

Whereas, the candidates who had qualified PET/PST for the said post and who were disqualified in PET/PST under the earlier advertisement notice needed not to apply again in response to the fresh advertisement notice as per the said advertisement notice, the contents of which are reproduced as under:-

“The candidates who had earlier qualified PET/PST for the post of constable in two Border Battalions in response to PHQ Advertisement Notice issued under endorsement No. Pers-Rectt-A-105-2018/16207-50 dated 09.03.2019 and qualified PET/PST need not apply again as they are eligible for the written examination.

Similarly, the candidates who were disqualified in PET/PST under the above quoted advertisement can not apply again as their applications would not be considered.”

Whereas, during the conduct of PET/PST under fresh advertisement notice, some candidates were detected who had applied under both the advertisement notices in contravention of the provisions prompting the PRB to scrutinize the data minutely.

Whereas, the implementing agency vide communication No. TTIL/ADM/2022/2927 dated 30.05.2022 submitted a list of 228 candidates along-with their data to this office who had submitted application forms in response to both the advertisement notices in violation of the laid down guidelines.

Whereas, the implementing agency vide its aforementioned communication has conveyed that it had uploaded the data of all the qualified and disqualified candidates under earlier advertisement notification thus disabling them to attempt to submit their application forms for fresh advertisement notice too.

Whereas, the implementing agency has intimated that a total number of 228 candidates have been detected who have managed to submit their application forms under fresh advertisement notice in spite of having appeared in PET/PST under earlier advertisement notice. They have submitted their online application forms in response to the fresh advertisement notice through fabrication of their personal data, with changed mobile number, email address and minor alteration in spelling of their name, parentage and address.

Whereas, out of 228 candidates, 198 candidates after having applied and appeared in PET/PST were disqualified in PET/PST under earlier notification, re-applied under fresh advertisement notice with changed and fabricated data, appeared in PET/PST and qualified the same.

Whereas, the remaining 30 candidates after having qualified the PET/PST under earlier advertisement notice have re-applied with changed/fabricated data and have qualified the PET/PST under fresh advertisement notification.

And Whereas, all these candidates have submitted their application forms under both the advertisement notifications which contradicted the contents of the fresh advertisement notice. It prompted the PRB to take a call on the issue in its meeting convened on 27.07.2022 in which it was unanimously decided to reject the candidature of all such candidates.

Now, therefore application forms submitted by 198 candidates under fresh advertisement notice issued under endstt. No. Pers-Rectt-A-105-2018/2500-50 dated 11.01.2022 whose details are depicted at Annexure "A" to this order are hereby **rejected** due to the reason that all these 198 candidates have submitted their application forms by changing/fabricating their personal data under fresh advertisement notice in violation of the contents of the said advertisement notification.

Similarly, the application forms of 30 candidates (whose details are contained at Annexure "B" to this order) submitted under fresh advertisement notice issued vide notification No. Pers-Rectt-A-105-2018/2500-50 dated 11.01.2022 are also hereby **rejected** due to the reason that they have submitted their online application forms in response to the fresh advertisement notice through fabrication of their personal data, with changed mobile number, email address and minor alteration in spelling of their name, parentage and address. Besides, the Police Recruitment Board has also decided to initiate legal action against all these 228 candidates for misleading this office by resorting to changing/fabrication of their personal data with malafide intentions.
